A FEW THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND WHEN STUFFING YOUR STOCKINGS...

- 1) Stockings are for children between the ages of infant-11. Sample items include:

	Small calendars	
Hair accessories	Color books & Crayons	Key chains
Small books	Card Games & Jacks	Jump ropes
Water bottles	Hygiene products	Memo pads
Watches	Socks	Stickers
Chalk	Rattlers, wash clothes, or pacifiers	Puzzles
Address books	(for infant stockings)	

**** No Candy or Food of any Kind is Allowed****

- 2) Choose goodies that allow us to distinguish boy's stockings from girl's and write in large letters BOY or GIRL on the cardboard topper. If your group has 25 or more of them please separate boys' from girls' stockings.
- 3) Stockings will be handled multiple times. Help keep them intact by not overstuffing them or attaching items to the outside. Also securely staple the cardboard topper.
- 4) Stockings signed out for a club, organization or business must be returned at the same time. Filled stockings must be returned to The Salvation Army by **Saturday, December 2nd** in order to have them ready for families to pick up during our Christmas distribution event.
